



Getting the best results for your design.

Over the years we have noticed that some things work for designs, and some things don't. Having the **cards designed in school** is definitely the best option. With great access to art supplies the results are usually better. So doing it as an Art Project is a good idea, and lots of fun. Design your card inside the area provided. Please keep the design away from the edge as it may be cut off in finishing. A few millimetres should be fine.

Make sure that the children have completed the order form on the back of the drawing sheet correctly, that their name is clear and readable. ***Please Note*** Orders for wrap and tags can **ONLY** be taken alongside an order for cards. Any queries on the order forms will result in a delay in the processing time for your order. If you can supply a class list this can be helpful when we pack the order. The cards will be returned to you in their classes with the class lists.

Best Results

Poster Paints (ensure that they are dry)

Felt Pens (non - fluorescent)

Chalk/Oil Pastels and Charcoal (please use fixing spray, hair spray can also be used)

Collage (must be securely fixed)

Fair Results

Pencils both colour and graphite can be good, **BUT** you must press firmly, light shading will not be picked up by the scanner.

Don't Use

Fluorescent ink/paper

Reflective/Holographic paper/stickers

Metallic paper, pens or paint.

Glitter, cotton-wool, 3D stickers.

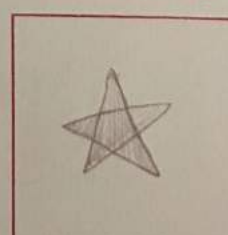
